ELECTRIFICATION OF RAILWAY LINE IN MAHARASHTRA

**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Railways have received proposals from the State Government of Maharashtra for electrification of rail lines in the State;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the action taken by the Railways thereon?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

(a) to (c): No proposal has been received from the State Government of Maharashtra for electrification of railway lines in the State. However, the electrification of Daund-Manmad section (255 Route Kilometres) and Gondia-Ballharshah (250 Route Kilometres) have been proposed in Rail Budget 2010-11. In addition to above, the electrification of Pune-Wadi-Guntakal rail line has already been sanctioned with doubling of Daund-Gulbarga rail line at a cost of Rs.1437.79 crore in October 2009.
