(a) whether the Government has formulated or proposes to formulate National Rural Housing Policy and Housing Guarantee Scheme on the lines of Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS);

(b) if so, the details thereof alongwith the proposed fund allocation for each State;

(c) whether the Government has received any proposals from certain quarters on the issue;

(d) if so, the details thereof and the action taken thereon; and

(e) the time by which it is likely to be implemented indicating the estimated number of beneficiaries thereunder?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI PRADEEP JAIN `ADITYA`)

(a) to (e) No Sir, there is no proposal to formulate a National Rural Housing Policy and Housing Guarantee Scheme on the lines of MGNREGS. However, a National Rural Housing & Habitat Policy has been drafted by the Ministry after wide consultation with the stakeholders including State Governments, bankers etc. The goal of the proposed Policy is `to ensure adequate and affordable housing for all and facilitate development of sustainable and inclusive habitats in rural areas by expanding Government support, promoting community participation, self-help and public-private partnership within the framework of Panchayati Raj.`

The draft policy is at consultation stage with the Planning Commission.
