(d): At present, the Government of India administers the Total Sanitation Campaign (TSC), a comprehensive programme to ensure sanitation facilities in rural areas with the main goal of eradicating the practice of open defecation and ensuring clean environment. TSC is a demand driven programme. As per the goals set under TSC, sanitation coverage shall be completed in the entire rural areas of the country by the year 2012.
