## **Answer**

## MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF STEEL (SHRI A. SAI PRATHAP)

(a)&(b): As per Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) Policy of Government of India 100% FDI is allowed in steel through automatic route.

However, as per the information available in the Ministry of Steel, there are two major Foreign Direct investment in the steel sector for setting up integrated steel projects in the country. These are, Arcellor Mittal India Limited and Posco India Limited. They have signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoUs) with the State Governments of Orissa and Jharkhand to set up new steel units in the country as per the following:-
