(a), (b) & (c) The permissible activities under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA), as laid down in schedule 1 of the Act, include inter alia drought proofing works such as afforestation and tree plantation. Further, to strengthen dovetailing of afforestation schemes with the MGNREGA, convergence guidelines have been issued by the Ministries of Rural Development and Environment and Forests

The State-wise details of the drought proofing (including afforestation and tree plantation) and land development (including plantation, land leveling etc.) works taken up under MGNREGA during 2007-08 to 2009-10 (upto January 2010) are given in Annexure.
