- (a) whether UN State of World's Indigenous Peoples Report 2010 has found that indigenous people in India suffer disproportionately high levels of poverty, illiteracy, poor health and human rights abuse;
- (b) if so, the facts and details thereof;
- (c) whether large dams and other infrastructural projects displaced these people without the adequate compensations;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the reaction of the Government thereto?
