**Will the Minister of POWER be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether both units of gas-based power plants of National Thermal Power Corporation Limited (NTPC) at Dadri have been commissioned;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not, the reasons for delay in commissioning of the plants; and
- (d) the steps taken or being taken for early commissioning of these units?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF POWER (SHRI BHARATSINH SOLANKI)

(a) & (b): NTPC's Dadri Combined Cycle Gas Based Power Plant of capacity 829.78 MW (4 Units of Gas Turbines of 130.19 MW each and 2 units of Steam Turbines of 154.51 MW each) have been commissioned between years 1992 to 1994. No other Unit of gas based power plant at Dadri is under construction at present.
