(a) to (e): National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) has decided to put up display boards on all ongoing/completed projects of NHAI at every 25 km on both sides, with a view to display project related information for the benefit of road users to be put up at the cost of concessionaire/contractors with no expenditure to be borne by NHAI.146 display boards have been prepared/erected in various States.
