**Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the National Highways Authority of India (NHA) is considering to erect bill boards on the National Highways;
- (b) if so, the total number of such bill boards and the total expenditure likely to be incurred in this regard;
- (c) the details of the content such bill boards are likely to depict;
- (d) whether such bill boards are likely to carry the pictures of national leaders of our freedom struggle; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (e): National Highways Authority of India (NHA) has decided to put up display boards on all ongoing/completed projects of NHA at every 25 km on both sides, with a view to display project related information for the benefit of road users to be put up at the cost of concessionaire/contractors with no expenditure to be borne by NHA. 146 display boards have been prepared/erected in various States.
