- (a) the estimated cost for eight laning of National Highway No.4 between Bangalore and Nelamangala in Karnataka;
- (b) the status of implementation of the project;
- (c) the amount sanctioned/ released and utilized for the project;
- (d) the time by which the project is likely to be completed; and
- (e) the steps taken/proposed to be taken for its early completion?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI R.P.N. SINGH)

- (a): The estimated cost of the project is Rs. 445 crores.
- (b): The 91.55% of the project is completed as on 31-01-2010.
- (c): This is a BOT Project and no expenditure is incurred by NHAI.
- (d): The project is likely to be completed in 2010.
- (e) All hindrances like land acquisition, shifting of temple at Arisinakunte village etc. have been removed and there is no hindrance at present.
