## Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether various National Highway projects have been cleared by the Cabinet Committee including expansion of the existing four lane section of the Golden Quadrilateral project in Maharashtra, Gujarat and Rajasthan into six lanes;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the estimated cost for executing such projects alongwith the manner in which the said projects are likely to be financed and executed; and
- (c) the time by which such projects are likely to be completed?

- (b) to (c): The details of various projects including the estimated cost of 4/6 laning projects, approved by the Government in the States of Maharashtra, Gujarat and Rajasthan are enclosed as Annexure A. The construction period for various projects would range from 30 to 36 months from the appointed date.
