(a) & (b): No, Madam. However, on the request of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, an exhibition train namely "Red Ribbon Express" has been started for a one year period, from 1st December, 2009, as a project of National Aids Control Organisation (NACO). The itinerary of the train, which is decided by NACO, covers some locations which were also covered during the earlier run.
