- (iii) Pune-Howrah AC (Bi-weekly)
- (iv) Mumbai-Ernakulam AC (Bi-weekly)
- (v) Indore-Mumbai AC (Bi-weekly)
- (vi) Jaipur-Mumbai AC (Bi-weekly)
- (vii) Chandigarh-Amritsar.
- (viii) Chennai-Coimbatore.
- (ix) Puri-Howrah.
- (x) Howrah-Digha.
