(a) to (c) Yes, Madam. A commando training centre has been sanctioned at an estimated cost of Rs. 26.70 crore. It will be a specialized training centre where Railway Protection Force and Railway Protection Special Force personnel will be given commando training. Other specialized courses will also be run on railway security related subjects.
