Will the Minister of COAL be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has conducted any survey for coal mining during the last three years;
- (b) if so, the details alongwith the quantity of coal reserves found, location wise;
- (c) whether certain malpractices were noticed in the allotment of coal from these places due to which coal companies have suffered losses; and
- (d) the location-wise amount of the loss incurred by the Union Government in the mining of coal from such locations?

Answer

(a) & (b): Yes, Sir. Exploration for coal is a continuous process and Geological Survey of India (GSI) under Ministry of Mines is vested with the responsibility for conducting regional exploration of various minerals including coal. Besides, Ministry of Coal through a Plan Scheme of Promotional / regional exploration conducts exploration for coal to supplement the efforts of GSI. Further, coal companies conduct detailed exploration in their command areas for proving coal reserves for preparing projects and to take up coal production. On the basis of exploration carried out by different agencies GSI prepares resource data on 1st April every year. As per the data published by GSI as on 01.04.2009 the estimated coal resources stand at 267.21 billion tonnes and state wise position of estimated coal recourses is furnished in the table below:(Resource in million tonnes)
