(a)&(b): The Centrally Sponsored Schemes and the Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana of the Department of Agriculture & Cooperation are for the development of agriculture in all parts of the country including hilly regions. However for the North Eastern States & hilly states like J & K, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Sikkim, a scheme 'Technology Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture in North Eastern States including Sikkim, Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand' is being implemented in the horticulture sector. Department of Agriculture & Cooperation is implementing a number of Centrally Sponsored Scheme to increase the productivity and production in the agriculture sector in the country like

- (i) Integrated Scheme of Pulses, Oilpalm and Maize
- (ii) National Horticulture Mission
- (iii) National Food Security Mission
- (iv) Micro Irrigation
- (v) Macro Management of Agriculture
- (iv) National Bamboo Mission
- (vii) Technology Mission on Cotton
- (viii) Support to State Extension Programmes for Extensions Reforms and
- (ix) National Project on Management of Soil Health & Fertility. A State Plan Scheme 'Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana' is also being implemented in the entire country including all hilly areas.
