- (a) whether Government has implemented any action plan/scheme for the development of pulses, vegetables, fruits, cereals and sugarcane, etc. in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the funds released to the States for this purpose during each of the last three years, item-wise and State-wise;
- (d) whether the funds released for the purpose were fully utilized; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam.Department of Agriculture and Cooperation has implemented a number of Centrally Sponsored Schemes to increase production & productivity in the agriculture sector including pulses, vegetables, fruits, cereals and sugarcane, etc. like
- (i) Integrated Scheme of Pulses, Oilpalm and Maize,
- (ii) National Horticulture Mission,
- (iii) National Food Security Mission,
- (iv) Micro Irrigation
- (v) Technology Mission of Horticulture in the North Eastern states including Sikkim, Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand, and
- (vi) Macro Management of Agriculture. Funds available under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana are also being used for this purpose.
- (c) & (d): A Statement indicating the State-wise releases and funds utilized under these Centrally Sponsored schemes during last three years is enclosed at Annexure I(i-vii).
- (e): Funds could not be fully utilized in some States due to delay in supply of inputs, delay in release of money to implementing agencies etc.
