(a) & (b): Different Export Organisations like FIEO, Export Promotion Councils and Commodity Boards etc. have sent various suggestions/ requests for supporting exports. Government and RBI are closely monitoring the economic developments in the country and internationally and have been taking appropriate steps to arrest the decline in exports. Government closely monitors the different export sectors and need based measures are taken keeping in view the financial implications. Measures announced in the form of stimulus packages (including the Trade Facilitation Measures announced in February '09) and in the Budget 2009-10, by the Government, particularly for exporting sector, is given in Annexure I.
