(a) to (c): While there is no such specific Scheme, the XI Plan document envisages, among other things, schemes to assist in the establishment of model degree colleges in 374 identified educationally backward districts and incentivize State Governments to establish new universities or colleges or expand existing institutions with focus on undercovered areas. Individual beneficiary schemes including a scheme to provide interest subsidy for the period of moratorium on Educational Loans taken by students from economically weaker sections from Scheduled Banks to pursue technical/professional education studies.
