## Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether India has raised concerns with Chinese Government over the issue of fake Chinese drugs, being sold in Nigeria under `Made in India` lable;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and efforts being made to improve India's brand image in Africa;
- (c) whether India has been resisting proposal for creation of properly streamlined transnational anti-counterfeiting regime; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor?

## **Answer**

- (a)&(b) Yes, India has lodged a strong protest with concerned Chinese authorities over the issue of fake Chinese drugs being sold in Nigeria under the 'Made in India' label but produced in China, with a request to take strict action against such unscrupulous elements.
- (c) & (d) Anti Counterfeit Trade Agreement (ACTA) is a plurilateral agreement which is yet to be finalized and India is not a party to these negotiations.
