- (a) whether India-Bangladesh has set up a joint venture power plant;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the name of the States in the country to be benefited therefrom?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF POWER (SHRI BHARATSINH SOLANKI)

(a) to (c): No, Madam. However, it has been agreed in principle that upon establishing the techno-economic feasibility, one coal based power plant would be developed through Joint Venture between Bangladesh Power Development Board (BPDB) and National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC), subject to approval of the respective Governments.
