(a)& (b): The Ministry has prepared and brought out a Report on 'Gendering Human Development Indices: Recasting the Gender Development Index (GDI) and Gender Empowerment Measure (GEM) for India. This report is also available on the Ministry's website: www.wcd.nic.in. GDI & GEM indices, computed for India for the year 1996 and 2006 are:-

GDI is 0.514 for 1996 & 0.590 for 2006. GEM is 0.416 for 1996 & 0.497 for 2006.

This shows a decline over the decade in the gender based disparity.
