PROVISION OF LOW COST COMPUTERS

Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

- (a) the percentage of people having access to Computer and Internet in the country, State-wise;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to make available low cost computers to bridge the digital divide in the country;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the time by which these are likely to be provided?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI SACHIN PILOT)

(a): India has an installed base of around 30 million computers for a population of 1.2 billion (PC penetration about 2.5%). The total number of Internet subscribers is 15.16 million as on December, 2009. Details as per State -wise data are at Annexure. Assuming 5 users per subscription, there will be 76 million users (Internet penetration approx. 6.3%).

(b),(c) and (d): Government is providing subsidy through Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF) to spread the broadband connectivity in rural areas including supply of low cost computers. Government has taken steps to promote electronic hardware manufacturing covering investment and favourable tariff regimes.
