However, in so far as the Central Government hospitals located in Delhi namely, Safdarjung Hospital, Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital and Lady Hardinge Medical College & Associated Hospitals are concerned, the space has been earmarked to open outlets in order to make available generic drugs at reasonable and affordable prices.
