- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

## MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) FOR MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI DINSHA PATEL)

- (a) The objective of Rajiv Gandhi Udyami Mitra Yojana (RGUMY) is to provide handholding support to first generation entrepreneurs in the establishment and management of their enterprise. The handholding support is provided through the empanelled lead agencies i.e. 'Udyami Mitras'. For rendering this support, the Government provides assistance in the form of hand-holding charges to Udyami Mitras.
- (b) The details of funds provided by the Government for the scheme during the last three years and the current year are as under:
