(b) & (c): Ministry has received 83 proposals amounting to Rs.1352.68 crore from Government of Madhya Pradesh under CRF during the financial year 2009-10, out of which 56 proposals amounting to Rs. 782.68 crore have been sanctioned so far, 24 proposals have been returned unapproved and three proposals are under consideration of the Ministry.
