CONVERSION OF NH-24 INTO EIGHT LANE

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to convert National Highway No.24 into 8 lanes;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, stretch-wise; and
- (c) the time by which the above project is likely to commence alongwith the cost likely to be incurred thereon?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI R. P. N. SINGH)

(a) to (c): The stretch of NH-24 falling in National Capital Territory of Delhi is already 8-lane except the stretch from Km.5.70 to Km.6.80 in which the work of 8-laning is in progress and targeted for completion by May, 2010. For the stretch of NH-24 falling in the State of Uttar Pradesh, there is no proposal to convert NH-24 into 8 lanes at present.
