- (a) whether some proposals from the State Governments including Karnataka State under the scheme of Inter-State connectivity are pending with the Union Government;
- (b) if so, the details and present status; thereof; and
- (c) the time by which the proposals are likely to be approved/cleared?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI R.P.N. SINGH)

(a) to (c): 108 proposals have been received from various State Governments including 10 proposals from the State Government of Karnataka for development of State Roads under the scheme of Inter-State connectivity (ISC) during 2009-10. Out of this, 20 proposals including 2 proposals for the State of Karnataka have been approved in principle, as on date. No commitment can be given for awarding in-principle approval for balance proposals, as it depends upon availability of funds, conformance to stipulated criteria, etc.
