(a): The Ministry of Labour & Employment has initiated action for rehabilitation of the beedi workers by providing them vocational training in certain courses according to the local market needs for viable alternative sources of livelihood.

(b) & (c): Details of the training programmes conducted at various places is given in Annexure. No record has been maintained regarding the number of beedi workers who have been shifted to alternative vocations.
