IMPROVEMENT IN THE CONDITION OF HOSPITALS

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government hospitals in the country including Delhi are in pitiable condition;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government has conducted any survey in this regard;
- (d) if so, the findings of the survey thereof; and
- (e) the measures taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to improve the condition of these hospitals?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI GHULAM NABIAZAD)

(a) to (e): Health being a State Subject, such information is not maintained centrally. In so far as Central Government Hospitals in Delhi are concerned, adequate medical arrangements are available in all the departments of the hospitals and are maintained with the required equipments which are closely monitored by the respective Medical Superintendents.
