(a) & (b): Based on the representations received and wide consultations with all stakeholders, it has been proposed to amend the Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972 to enhance the existing ceiling of Rs. 3.5 lakh on the maximum amount of gratuity payable under the Act to Rs. 10 lakh.
