(a) to (e): Government has constituted an expert committee for formulation of proposed Rajiv Awas Yojana (RAY), aimed at making India Slum-free. The Committee will make suggestions regarding the strategies, financial pattern and other features of RAY. As the expert committee has been set up recently, it is too early to decide on the parameters of the scheme such as pattern of funding and number of houses to be taken up under RAY.
