- (a) whether Azadpur Mandi has been declared as a market of National importance by the Government of NCT of Delhi;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether fruits and vegetables arrive in Azadpur Mandi from all States of the country;
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State-wise; and
- (e) the details of business turnover of traders in APMC Azadpur and commission charged from the farmers and gardeners during the last three years and the current year?

- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam. The azadpur mandi was declared a Market of National Importance (MNI) under the provision of Section 26 of Delhi Agricultural Produce Marketing (Regulation) Act, 1998.
- (c) & (d): Yes, Madam. The state-wise arrival of fruits and vegetables is given at annexure.
- (e): The traders deposit one per cent of the sale value as market fees with the APMC, Azadpur. Based on this, the business turnover of trades in APMC, Azadpur during the last three financial years has been arrived as follows:-

2007-08 4099.56

The APMC is not charging any commission from farmers/gardeners etc.
