Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRI VINCENT H. PALA)

(a) No, Sir. The Treaty on sharing of Ganga/Ganges waters with Bangladesh at Farakka during the lean Period (from January to May every year) was signed by the Prime Ministers of both the countries in December, 1996 and it has a validity for 30 years. The Treaty is being implemented to the satisfaction of both the countries since 1997.
