- (a) & (b): Yes Madam.A Capsule Course on helpful attitude, verbal & non-verbal communication and basic communication in English for the police personnel of Delhi Police, to improve their language & behaviour skills ahead of Commonwealth Games-2010 is being organized with the help of outside Institutions/agencies. Three Institutions/ Agencies have been assigned the job. Till now 37,255 police officers/men have been trained.
- (c): An amount of Rs. 1,61,60,000/- have been allocated for the training by the Govt. of NCT of Delhi.
