(a) whether a number of housing colonies developed and allotted by the Delhi Development Authority and transferred to the Municipal Corporation of Delhi for providing civic amenities like roads, water, general cleanliness are in a poor state;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the steps taken or proposed to be taken to improve the civic amenities in such colonies?

(a) to (c): The Municipal Corporation of Delhi has informed that at present the civic amenities like roads and cleanliness of the colonies transferred to it are in satisfactory condition. Development and upgradation works like re-surfacing of roads, construction of footpath, construction of storm water drain, improvement of parks etc. are carried out as per requirement. The requirement of safai karamcharis and equipment/implements for general cleanliness in these colonies are assessed and provided.
