(a) to (e) Yes, Madam. The Government has formulated and approved a scheme for Leadership Development of Minority Women. Inputs received, inter-alia, from National Commission for Women (NCW) were also taken into account. NCW had envisaged a scheme which would reach out to minority women and help them to assume leadership roles in accessing services, skills and opportunities for improving their lives and livelihood.
