(a) and (b): Geological Survey of India (GSI) has delineated economic mineral(non-fuel) bearing area for heavy mineral sands, Oolites and calcarcous sands, lime mud occurrences, phosphatic sediment, construction grade sand, micro-manganese nodules and ferromanganese encrustations in East Coast (Orissa, Andhra Pradesh, Tamilnadu, Andaman and Nicobar Islands) and West Coast (Kerala, Maharashtra, Gujarat and Lakshadweep).

(c): Funds allocated for the exploration and development activities by the Geological Survey of India during each of the last three years and the current year are given below :-
