(a) & (b): The Centre for Wind Energy Technology, Chennai, set-up by Ministry of New and Renewable Energy, functions as an effective Technical Focal Point inter-alia, providing services such as Wind Resource Assessment, Testing and Certification of wind turbines and Research & Development for the promotion of wind energy in the country.

(c) & (d): The services of foreign scientists are availed, whenever required for specific purposes. Presently, C-WET is collaborating with RISO National Laboratory, Denmark for development of a Wind Prediction Model and for strengthening its Certification Services.
