(a), (b) & (c) The Centrally Sponsored Scheme on `Development of Inland Fisheries & Aquaculture` inter-alia, provides assistance to States to promote brackish water aquaculture in the country. Bihar, however, has not sought financial assistance under this component.

While no funds were released during the last three years for brackish water component, funds released during the current year (2009-10) for this component, are given in Annexure.
