(d) if so, the time by which it is likely to be completed?

(a) to (d): Taj Nagar Railway Station was sanctioned for opening a halt station through shramdan and with no capital expenditure by Railway. As per laid down norms, rail level platforms and booking cum waiting hall have been provided at this station. At present, there is no proposal for construction of concrete platforms and additional waiting room at this station.
