- (a) whether the Western Railway is in the process of converting the existing four track into six track railway line;
- (b) if so, the estimated cost of the project; and
- (c) the time by which the project is likely to be completed?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

- (a): A project has been taken up by Western Railway to add 6th line to existing 5th line (except Mahim- Santacruz) from Mumbai Central to Borivali under Mumbai Urban Transport Project (MUTP) Phase-II.
- (b): The completion cost has been projected to Rs. 522 crore.
- (c): MUTP Phase-II is targeted to be completed by March, 2014.
