ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FOR HEALTH SCHEMES

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the allocations of funds suggested by the Planning Commission for the Eleventh Five year Plan for various health Schemes in the country;
- (b) whether the provisions made in the Budget 2010-11 for the various health schemes are sufficient to take care of increasing health problems in the country;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the details of health schemes where all allocations made was less as compared to the previous year's Budget?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI GHULAM NABI AZAD)

- (a) to (c): Planning Commission has approved an outlay of Rs.140135 crores for Eleventh Five Year Plan for various Departments under Ministry of Health & Family Welfare. For the Financial year 2010-11, an outlay of Rs. 22300 crores has been provided for the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare representing an increase of 14.2% over the previous year's allocation of Rs. 19534 crores in the year 2009-10 budget.
- (d): There are three schemes namely Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY), Assistance to States for Capacity Building (Trauma Care) and National Vector Borne Disease Control Programme, where allocation in Budget 2010-11 is less as compared to the previous year's budgetary allocation.
