(a), (b) & (c): The Ministry of Tourism grants Central Financial Assistance (CFA) to State Governments/Union Territory Administrations for the development of tourist infrastructure. Implementation and monitoring of projects is the responsibility of the State Governments/ Union Territory Administrations. However, Ministry of Tourism also monitors the progress of the projects through Regional Conferences, review meeting with State Government officers and site visits.
