- (c) the targets fixed for export of wheat and wheat products during the said period in the country;and
- (d) the quantity of wheat and wheat products exported by the Government and the private sector during January to September, 2009?

- (d): There has been no export of wheat and wheat products on Government account during January to September, 2009. A quantity of 519.08 tonnes of wheat and 15,705.36 tonnes of wheat flour have been exported by private sector during above period.
