(a): As per data compiled by National Crime Record Bureau (NCRB), as on 31-12-2007 there were 4695 foreign nationals under detention in various jails in the country. A statement indicating State-wise break-up is given at annexure. Nationality wise information is, however, not maintained centrally.

(b): One German National viz. Mr Richard Rodrigques was granted remission of sentence on medical grounds under article 72 of the Constitution in the year 2007.
