## Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the number of Infected Drug Users (IDUs) is increasing in the NCT of Delhi;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has conducted any study in this regard;
- (d) if so, the details and the outcome thereof; and
- (e) the steps taken by the Government to control such problem in consultation with Health Ministry and Medical Fraternity?

## **Answer**

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN)

- (a) & (b): 6,070 to 9,605 injecting Drug Users are estimated to be in Delhi as per the India HIV Estimate 2006 (ICMR-NACO, Government of India).
- (c) & (d): No, Madam. However, the Department of AIDS Control, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare has proposed to take up a new mapping exercise to ascertain the number of IDUs in Delhi.
- (e): The department of AIDS Control, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare engages with NGOs to implement services for IDUs which includes identifying the IDUs, education on HIV/ AIDS, counseling, provision of sterile equipments, condoms, motivation and referral to testing centers, treatment of wounds, and sexually transmitted infections, etc.

In addition, a new treatment for IDUs called as Opioid substitution therapy is provided to wean the IDUs out of their injecting habit. The department is also in consultation with other Ministries/Departments for working on the issue of drug addiction.
