SAFETY MEASURES FOR COMMONWEALTH GAMES SITES

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of persons died/ injured at the Commonwealth Games sites, separately;
- (b) the total number of cases registered against the agencies on account of negligence and carrying out work without ensuring proper security equipment and medical facilities, agency-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has set up any Committee/Commission in this regard;
- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) the action taken against the agencies involved in such cases; and
- (f) the details of security/safety related measures/guidelines issued by the Government to each of the agencies?

Answer

- (a) & (b): A total of 16 persons have died and 08 persons have been injured at the Commonwealth Games sites. 22 cases have been registered against the agencies/contractors.
