Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether National Textile Corporation is going to set up new textile units in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof indicating the total number of such units likely to be set up in the country, State-wise; and
- (c) the details indicating total cost of setting up such units alongwith the combined production capacity likely to be increased after setting up these units in the country?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TEXTILES (SMT. PANABAAKA LAKSHMI)

(a) to (c): There is no such proposal for National Textile Corporation (NTC) to set up new textile units in the country. However, the Board for Industrial and Financial Reconstruction (BIFR), as per the Modified Rehabilitation Scheme, 2008 has approved relocation of 4 Green Field mills in the States of Maharashtra, Karnataka, Gujarat and Rajasthan by relocating the existing NTC mills in the same States. As per BIFR approval, the estimated total cost of relocation is Rs.580.81 crore. The projected additional capacity after relocation would be 15696 Spindles, 204 Looms and Processing capacity of 80000 Meters per day.
