- (a) & (b) The post of Vice Chancellor, Maulana Azad National Urdu University (MANUU), Hyderabad became vacant on 28.2.2009 upon the relinquishment of charge by Prof. A.M. Pathan on his appointment as Vice Chancellor, Central University of Karnataka. Thereafter, Prof. K.R. Iqbal Ahmed, Pro Vice-Chancellor is officiating as In-charge Vice-Chancellor as per the provisions of the Maulana Azad National Urdu University Act. The post of Controller of Examination became vacant upon the repatriation of the incumbent Dr. S. Jeelani to his parent department. Prof. S.A. Wahab is officiating as In-charge Controller of Examination. The academic and administrative activities of the University are running smoothly.
- (c) The Search and Selection Committee for filling up the post of Vice Chancellor, Maulana Azad National Urdu University, Hyderabad has already met in March, 2010 and its recommendations have been sent to the Hon'ble President of India in her capacity as Visitor of the University.
